**40 DAYS FOR LIFE VIGIL WRAPS UP AT THE
1st OFFICIAL “KEEP GOD IN AMERICA” RALLY IN JACKSONVILLE, FL
National Director David Bereit to Speak at Sunday, March 28 Concert**

David Bereit, National Director of 40 Days for Life, a pro-life organization focused on creating peaceful campaigns to put an end to abortion, will end the organization’s Jacksonville, Florida vigil at the Keep God in America Rally, Sunday, March 28, 2010.

40 Days for Life began when Bereit and three others prayed for an hour around an old wooden table in College Station, Texas while they sought God’s will on how to end the tragedy of abortion in their community. Since that first prayer session, 40 Days for Life has spread to 307 cities across all 50 America states and to seven other countries. 40 Days for Life organizes community-wide prayer groups, fasts and conducts peaceful vigils outside Planned Parenthood abortion facilities. Bereit states that 2,500 lives have been saved from abortion due to his groups efforts, and 27 abortion workers have left the abortion industry.

“As a nation, we have lost our way -- drifting further and further away from our Christian founding principles,” Bereit said. “In just the last ten years, crime, drug use, broken homes, promiscuity, perversion, and abortion have skyrocketed. This drastic crisis demands a drastic response. The “Keep God in America” event will point citizens to the source and strength of our nation – God Almighty – and the rally will educate, equip, and empower participants to transform our nation and restore America to its founding principles.”

Bereit met Keep God in America rally organizer Chris Nwasike in Washington, D.C. in January of 2010 when Nwasike traveled to there to attend the annual National Prayer Breakfast and to interview Congresswoman Michele Bachmann (MN), who gave her endorsement to the rally. Nwasike invited Bereit to end the 40-day Jacksonville vigil at the Sunday, March 28th concert and talk briefly about his organization’s work.

The first official “Keep God In America Rally” will be held in Jacksonville, Florida, March 26 - 28, 2010. The three-day event will include speaker sessions and a Sunday concert. The rally’s purpose is to educate, inspire and serve by spotlighting the role that America’s Judeo-Christian heritage has played -- and should continue to play -- in the success of the greatest free society in the history of mankind.

“I encourage every person of faith and conscience to join me in Jacksonville, Florida, on March 28 for the “Keep God in America” rally,” Bereit said. “It will be a hope-filled event that will inspire every participant to be part of the solution to the myriad of challenges that plague our America.”

Speaker events will take place on the campus of North Florida University, Friday from 6p.m. to 8p.m. and Saturday from 9a.m. to 4p.m. Featured guests include Dr. Rick Green of Wall Builders, Dr. Scarborough of Vision America, Matt Brock of Liberty Council. On Sunday, March 28, a Praise Concert will take place at Metropolitan Park across from Jaguars Stadium. Gates open at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday. Food vendors and merchandise booths will be on site. Attendees are encouraged to bring lawn chairs.
